Fisher stated that on Friday 15 April 2005 at approximately 1450 Hrs he drove past the Street of Shops building and that he observed a white over bright red Mini parked in the parking lot across the street in the gravel parking lot.

He believed that there were 3 or 4 other vehicles parked in the parking lot.

Fisher stated that the white over red vehicle was parked in the lower corner of the parking lot where all the water drains out and that the vehicle was parked approximately one car width away from any bushes or trees.

Fisher stated that he didn't see anyone inside or around the vehicle.

He stated that if we call back to talk to him to remember his mother who he lives with has dementia.
