3.3 One (1) Fingerprint Card of Susan KNISELY, DOB: 01/11/62.


CONCLUSIONS: 1 One (1) latent fingerprint from Item 2.1 and One (1) latent impression from Item 2.2 were compared to Items 3.1, 3.2, and 3.3.
2 One (1) latent fingerprint from Item 2.1 was identified to the Left Middle (#8) finger of Raymond Frank GRICAR.
The latent impression from Item 2.2 was not identified.
3 One (1) latent impression from Item 2.2 was searched through the Pennsylvania Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) and the FBI Integrated Automated Fingerprint Identification System (IAFIS).
4 The latent impression was not identified and was registered to the Unsolved Latent Print data base.
5 The remaining latent prints lacked sufficient ridge characteristics to be identifiable.
